



Power Line Scholarship Program Submittal Requirements

The student is responsible for submitting all materials on time. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated.

Checklist

- 1. Students who are planning to attend an **accredited power line technical college** must complete this four-page application (attach additional sheets if necessary). Your name and address should be on all attachments. Completeness and neatness ensure your application will be evaluated appropriately.
- 2. Copy of your recent academic transcript. To qualify for a power line technical college scholarship, you must have a high school cumulative grade average of at least a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- 3. ACT and/or SAT exam scores are **not** required to be considered for a power line technical college scholarship.
- 4. Handwritten questions – You must legibly handwrite a one paragraph answer to each of the following questions. To qualify for a scholarship, students must not use Chat GPT or any other artificial intelligence assistance program. If it is determined that an artificial intelligence assistance program is used to answer the following questions, your scholarship application will be disqualified.
 - What impact has Sioux Valley Energy had on your community?
 - Which of the seven cooperative principles stand out to you and why?
 - Why do you want to become a power line worker?
- 5. Letter of Reference – Include a letter of reference from a teacher, school counselor, employer, youth leader, or pastor.
- 6. Application must be signed by both the parent or guardian for the student to be considered. The parent or guardian must be a Sioux Valley Energy member.

Applications that are hand delivered must be in one of our service centers no later than 4 p.m. on Friday, January 12, 2024. Applications must be postmarked no later than Friday, January 12, 2024.

The Sioux Valley Energy Scholarship selection committee will review all scholarship applications and select scholarship awardees. All decisions are final.

The Scholarship Selection Committee is made up of a Sioux Valley Energy employee, Operation Round Up® Directors, a Sioux Valley Energy Director, and a school counselor.
