The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Sioux Valley-Southwestern Electric Cooperative, Inc. (dba. Sioux Valley Energy) was held on December 17th, 2018 commencing at 8:30 a.m. at the Colman headquarters in Colman, South Dakota.

REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION OF THE AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PLAN
