Scholarship Submittal Requirements

The student is responsible for submitting all materials on time. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated.

- ☐ 1. Complete this application (*attach additional sheets if necessary*). Your name and address should be on all attachments. Completeness and neatness ensure your application will be evaluated appropriately.
- ☐ 2. Copy of your recent academic transcript. You must have a high school cumulative grade average of: at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale to apply for those attending a 4-year College or University
at least a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale to apply for those attending a Vocational-Technical School
- ☐ 3. Copy of your college entrance examination (*ACT and/or SAT*) scores. You must have an ACT score of 21 or greater. If you are attending a Vocational-Technical School, the ACT score and/or SAT score is not required.
- ☐ 4. **Essay** – Pick one of the four values of innovation, accountability, integrity, or commitment to community and describe how you see this value in action in your local cooperative.
- ☐ 5. **Letter of Reference** – Include a letter of reference from a teacher, school counselor, employer, youth leader or pastor.
- ☐ 6. Application must be signed by both the parent and the student to be considered. The parent or guardian must be a Sioux Valley Energy customer.
